Highlights from the Year



Tamandua Birth

Reid Park Zoo rang in 2014 with the birth of a tamandua, or lesser anteater, born January 2nd. The Zoo has built a very successful breeding program for tamanduas, and has become recognized as a source of expert information on successfully keeping and breeding this species. Although tamanduas are not on exhibit at the Zoo, they are featured in education programs and public presentations on Zoo grounds.



Lion Cubs' Debut

Four African lion cubs born in late 2013 made their public debut on February 27, 2014. This is the second litter of cubs for male Shombay and female Kaya. The youngsters are still currently housed at Reid Park Zoo, but will soon leave for other AZA accredited facilities to start families of their own. Reid Park Zoo partners with colleague facilities to make responsible breeding decisions for the protection of the species; this will likely be the pair's last set of cubs.



Flamingo Chicks

Two Chilean flamingo chicks hatched in the fall of 2014: a female in October and a male in November. The gray and downy youngsters integrated well with the rest of the flock, and can now be seen walking and swimming around their exhibit daily. They will start growing their pink adult feathers during the coming year.

Attendance Record

In 2014, Reid Park Zoo hosted 618,482 visitors, making it the highest attended year in the history of the Zoo.

Camel Rides

The Zoo added a significant new attraction in November of 2014: camel rides! This popular feature makes use of the former elephant exhibit, giving new life to a central area of the Zoo. The four male camels—Luke, Riddle, Mack and Winston—are a real crowd pleaser.



Accreditation

Every five years, the Zoo undergoes a thorough review and inspection to demonstrate that it continues to meet or exceed professional standards for excellence in animal care, veterinary programs, conservation, education, and safety. A team from the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) spent multiple days at the Zoo in February, interviewing staff members and inspecting everything from exhibits to education to arounds. The Zoo received its accreditation renewal in March. making it a proud member of AZA for five more years!

Baby Elephant Nandi

Semba, a 24-year old African Elephant, successfully delivered a female calf at 10:55pm on August 20, 2014. The calf weighed 245 lbs at birth and began nursing within her first hour of life.



After a public vote, the calf was named "Nandi," meaning "sweet and fun" in the African language siSwati. She has proven it to be a perfect name by capturing the hearts of Tucson residents.



Nandi interacts well with other herd members, and gains strength and coordination each day.



Nandi has been gaining 3-5 pounds per day and weighed over 650 pounds at her 6-month birthday!

Education Programs

The Zoo's education department provides a wide range of programs and experiences to capture the interest of children and adults. From school tours to animal training demonstrations, the Zoo is an education resource for the community.

Education Goals:

- Connect our community to the amazing lives of exotic animals
- Promote awareness about the diversity of wildlife...and why it's important
- Communicate the role of the Zoo (and its animal expert staff members) in conservation
- Work to protect wildlife and wild places, and inspire our audiences to help too
- Provide safe, memorable, and fun learning experiences for all

Self-Guided Field Trips

For just \$2 per person, teachers can make arrangements to have students and chaperones visit the Zoo. Free downloadable activities and materials as well as Bio Bags are available for teachers to make sure each visit is hands-on, meaningful, and outcome-based.

STEM Education

We developed new education activities featuring GPS technology to strengthen our STEM programming. We initially created the activities for high school students from Salpointe, but then adapted them for younger students, including 3rd graders and our elementary school-aged summer campers.

Teacher Workshops

We hosted two teacher workshops to familiarize approximately 38 Pre-K through 2nd Grade teachers with the Zoo's early education science curriculum and the guided activities we offer to supplement classroom instruction.

Community Outreach

We partnered with the Pima County Public Library over the summer to offer "Be a Biologist," a program at 14 different library branches in conjunction with their summer reading program, culminating with an end-of-the-summer celebration at the Zoo.







Conservation – Worldwide

Each time a guest participates in the Zoo's Giraffe Encounter, the proceeds contribute to field programs, protecting animals around the world.

Reid Park Zoo and The Zoological Society supported many conservation projects regionally and internationally, providing much needed financial support.

Grevy's Zebra Trust

Working in partnership with St. Louis Zoo to address urgent needs related to the Grevy's zebra (Equus grevyi) in the community rangelands of Ethiopia and Kenya.

International Elephant Foundation (IEF)

Supporting conservation, education, and research of the world's elephants - resulting in the protection of elephants for future generations

New Nature Foundation-Kibale Fuel Wood Project in Uganda

Protecting trees through education programs and the distribution of fuel-efficient stoves. When the park's trees are healthy, the animals that live there are too!

Hyderabad Tiger Conservation Society (HyTiCoS)

Working in partnership with the University of Arizona's Wild Cat Research and Conservation Center to protect tigers and their ecosystem.

International Rhino Foundation

Protecting all five living rhino species (Black, White, Indian, Sumatran, and Javan) and their habitats in the wild, while also supporting management of and research on captive populations.

Wildlife SOS

Working to rescue India's wildlife from exploitation and abuse, and protecting habitats of wild species.

Tarangire Elephant Project

Conserving the African Elephant through grassroots field research efforts while working with local people to create a community based approach to protecting elephants.

Pantanal Giant Armadillo and Anteater Project

Establishing long-term ecological study of armadillos and anteaters in the Pantanal using radio transmitters, camera traps, resource mapping, and other monitoring.

Docents

Reid Park Zoo's dedicated group of 108 docents (volunteer educators) donated 16,243 hours of their time in 2014 and raised \$10,000 for the new Health Center. Docents provide:

- interactive "stations" throughout the Zoo
- encounters with education animals
- expertise in the information booth... and much more!

Teen Volunteers

Teen Volunteers are an energetic support group for programs and events, and engage visitors through interpretive "stations" and animal encounters. The current group of 50 teens also raises funds and awareness for conservation. In 2014 they raised \$10,507! The Zoo teens are empowered to manage the gifts, as well as the associated messaging communicated to Zoo guests.

College Internships

Throughout 2014 there were 56 college students who completed formal internships for credit at the Zoo. Collectively, these educational opportunities provided 7,291 hours of on-grounds learning experience for the students. Interns provide support alongside our professional Zoo Keeping staff as they learn what it takes to become an animal care expert.

Elephant Care Center Volunteers

A dedicated group of adult volunteers contribute many hours of hard work behindthe-scenes at the Elephant Care Center, in the Health Center, and in the Zoo Commissary. While they do not work directly with animals, their record keeping, raking, hosing, food prep and enrichment building are essential support for the Zoo Keepers.

Future Projects

New Gibbon Habitat


Reid Park Zoo's gibbons -- Billy, Moms, and Lilith -- will be moving to a new home during 2015! Their current exhibit area was built more than 25 years ago, and this ever-popular family of gibbons is ready for new space.

The new habitat, to be located near the tigers, will feature a glass wall for close-up ape encounters. It will also have a tall mesh roof with lots of space for treetop exploring, and an aerial walkway for extended roaming. A behind-the-scenes night house will keep this active and engaging species warm during colder months.

Wildlife Carousel

What's the next best thing to actually hugging your favorite zoo animal? Taking a ride on the back of that creature on the Zoo's soon-to-be-built Wildlife Carouse!!

Under a 36' thatched safari roof, 30 hand-painted replicas of exotic animals will glide to the beat of global rhythms. Here a child's dream of riding an elephant, a giant anteater, a rhino, or a giraffe can come true. Children will get to touch the endangered species of our world, creating an unforgettable experience that is both enjoyable and educational. The anticipated opening date is December 2015.









Animal Health Center Expansion

Providing whole-life health care for over 400 animals representing 100+ species is a big challenge. The Zoo has far outgrown its current small health clinic, originally built in 1978.

The Zoo's new Animal Health Center, currently in the design and fundraising stage, will more than double the available space and include the latest technological advances in veterinary health care. Features will include:

- Treatment facilities for animals of all types and sizes
- A surgical suite
- Intensive care unit
- State-of-the-art medical equipment
- Education center with views into treatment areas

The expanded Health Center will provide first-rate care for the Zoo's animal collection, for today and tomorrow. It also will help to train future veterinarians, as students have the opportunity to learn about whole-life animal care by observing and assisting in the Health Center.
